Diamony

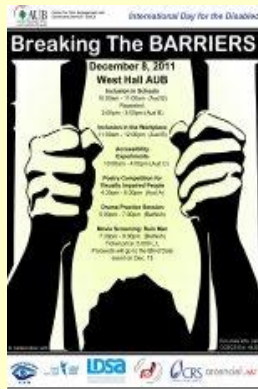

HSBC donation

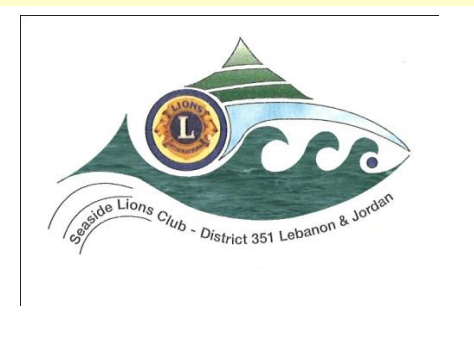
The HSBC bank assigned the total requested budget of 36.000 USD for the proposal entitled “Promoting the educational integration of children with Autism in Lebanon”
